Dear Loyola School Community,

I am very pleased and excited to announce the appointment of Adam Lewis as the next Principal of Loyola School. Mr. Lewis's selection is the culmination of an extensive global search. This fall, after narrowing a broad pool of candidates, our search committee met with semifinalists and decided upon a group of terrific finalists for this important leadership role. School leadership and representatives continued conversations with three selected finalists which included an opportunity to meet with administration, faculty, students, alumni, trustees, and parent representatives.

In considering who the next Principal of Loyola School would be, we recognized the importance of selecting a candidate who is well grounded in the Ignatian tradition and possesses a deep understanding of Jesuit secondary education; Mr. Lewis clearly demonstrated those characteristics and many more wonderful professional traits. He will officially begin his responsibilities as Loyola's Principal on July 1, 2017, and we are already working with Mr. Lewis and Dr. Ross Cully to ensure that his transition will be a smooth one.

Mr. Lewis, a native of Australia, brings an impressive breadth of experience from a variety of educational settings. He has been Director of Senior Campus for Xavier College (Melbourne, Australia) since 2015 and from 2010 to 2015 was Deputy Principal of Saint Ignatius College Riverview (Sydney, Australia). From 2000 to 2008, Mr. Lewis taught History and English and was a Housemaster at Clongowes Wood College SJ (Clane, Ireland) and taught English at Sacred Heart R.C. Secondary School (London, United Kingdom), 1998 to 2000. He earned a B.A and a B.S at the Australian National University; a Graduate Diploma in Education from the University of Canberra in 1998; and a Master of Arts in Applied Developmental and Educational Psychology from Boston College in 2010. Mr. Lewis is married to Eadaoin, a native of Ireland, and they have three young children; Isaac (7), Paddy (5) and Elsie (2). The whole family is very much looking forward to moving to New York City and joining our Loyola School community.

I am extremely grateful to our Search Committee, and other community leaders, for the hours they dedicated to this important process. I also wish to express my appreciation to Dr. Ross Cully for her contributions to Loyola as our Principal and for the role she will play in helping Mr. Lewis transition to his new position.

Please join me in extending Adam Lewis an enthusiastic welcome as Loyola School's next Principal!
